## **Travelodge**


I strongly oppose plans from Travelodge revealed last month to build a hotel on council land potentially using council funding.

## **Around the Constituency**

In June, I was honoured to be the first Scottish MP to sign up to the Carer Positive employment scheme.

Run by Carers Scotland on behalf of the Scottish Government, Carer Positive awards are presented to employers in Scotland who have a working environment where carers are valued and supported – recognising the benefits to employers as well as helping individual staff and their families.

While caring for my husband George, my experiences have given me a new found appreciation for the work that carers across Scotland do and I call on firms to complete the simple self-assessment process themselves.

Later in the month, my office held suicide alertness training - safeTALK - for elected representatives in the area, their staff, and local organisations.

It is a vitally important and thoroughly worthwhile course that will stand everyone who attended in good stead in the future. And trainers Lynne and David ensured that discussions were candid and engaging, despite the often difficult subject of the training.

For Volunteers' Week, I visited Chris's House and FAMS who provide support around mental health and dealing with grief. The recent loss of local young men through suicide highlights the great need for these organisations and the work they do.

June was also Duchenne Awareness Month and I was keen to highlight the genetic disorder which affects around 2,500 people in the UK today.



## **Westminster Review**

As well as participating in the effective and necessary walkout of SNP MPs, I was also able to raise a number of issues at the House of Commons last month. Following the debacle that was the miniscule 15 minute debate on devolution, I sought to raise the matter of electronic voting within the Parliament as the current archaic systems simply do not work.


